We are setting up our exhibit at the Galleria, Living Arts Centre foyer on the main floor and lengthened the time of the exhibit to provide artists with the maximum exposure. Additionally, we have reduced our fees this year to encourage all of you to participate. We are also hosting a few other exhibits such as MuslimFest's own GTA Mosques Exhibit and The Majestic Qur'an Exhibit. 1. Deadline for **accepting applications** is Friday, July 6th, 2009. All art work must be received no later than Friday, July 18th, 2009.
2. All artwork must be approved by the International Art Exhibit Coordinator and MuslimFest's Board of Directors. Submission of artwork does not guarantee approval.
3. Submitted artwork must be respectful of Islamic teachings and sensitive to Muslim ideals.
4. Artists assume responsibility over all of their artwork. Artists pay two-way shipping, customs, and any other handling costs. Local artists should pick up their artwork by 8:00 p.m. on August 2, 2009 from the Art Exhibit coordinator. All artwork unpicked up by Friday, August 15, 2009 becomes the property of DawaNet Canada.
5. All profits generated by the sale of artwork will be split by the artist and MuslimFest as follows:
15% MuslimFest
85% Artist
6. Photographs or recordings of all artworks must be submitted for pre-approval in the form of CD, DVD or VHS in NTSC format with this application. For work not yet produced, a detailed description on paper with a sketch is required. All of the above materials become the property of MuslimFest and will not be returned.
7. All non-digital prints of photographs should be made from Artist's original negatives and processed by the Artist or under his/her supervision, signed and numbered.
8. All art work should include hangers.
9. The attached 'International Art Exhibit Submission Call for Entries Application' must be filled and enclosed with any submission.
10. Please attach a photo & brief biography (150 words) that includes education background, previous exhibits, and style of artwork.
11. All applications not following these guidelines will be discarded. The artist will be informed to submit a new application.
Payment will not be refunded.

By submitting this form I affirm that all submitted work is original, and produced solely by myself, the applicant. I understand that MuslimFest 2009 reserves the right to remove any works that do not meet the standards set forth in the prospectus. I release to MuslimFest the right to use my artwork, or re-productions there of, and my information for the promotion of MuslimFest or any other event held by DawaNet Canada.
