BAAZAR SPACE TERMS AND CONDITIONS

1. MuslimFest will issue a confirmation letter/email to accepted Bazaar contracts.
2. Table space includes a 6'x2' display table, a table cover, I.D sign and two (2) chairs.
3. The bazaar area will operate from 11:00 a.m. to 10:00 p.m.
4. No displaying, advertising or selling of ANY **Sound Vision products**.
5. No displaying, advertising, or selling of ANY CDs or Products of artists performing at **MuslimFest 2008**.
6. Every outdoor vendor selling products or services is required to have a vendor permit/license that MuslimFest will arrange for at a cost of \$50.
7. No displaying, advertising or selling of un-Islamic materials (Un-Islamic material is that which is identified and labelled as such according to Islamic sources and ethics.)
8. Merchandise is to be displayed in an organized, presentable manner, without disrupting the flow of traffic. (i.e. dresses are to be hung; hijabs are to be folded.)
9. NO FOOD or BEVERAGES MAY BE SOLD BY THE VENDORS AT THE BAZAAR, or distributed at no charge, unless authorized by **MuslimFest**.
10. Exhibitors may not move from their assigned booth, encroach on another vendor's space, move their assigned booth, and move tables and chairs from other booths.
11. Allocation of tables will be determined on a first-come-first-serve basis. To ensure your spot in a timely manner, please submit your completed forms and payments before the above-mentioned deadline. There will be no reservations without payment.
12. The bazaar committee has the right to assign tables, and their decision is final.
13. Fireworks, incendiary devices, or heating appliances are strictly prohibited.
14. No fundraising may be done the bazaar area.
15. Exhibitors and their staff are expected to maintain Islamic etiquette and courteous behaviour when dealing with customers and soliciting business.
16. Bazaar Tables will only be confirmed upon receiving payment in full. MuslimFest will confirm table once cheques are cleared and credit card payments are processed. There will be no exception given by anyone to anyone.
17. Banners are only allowed within your tent space. No banners to be hanged on walls or other city property buildings.
18. All vendors are responsible for getting their own general

liability insurance with a minimum of \$2,000,000 liability insurance, adding the City of Mississauga as an additional insured for the overall event.

19. Indemnity Clause:

a. Exhibitors and their staff indemnify and hold MuslimFest, the City of Mississauga, and the Living Arts Centre or any of their organizers harmless from and against all costs, damages, judgments or legal expenses which may arise from this agreement, set-up, exhibition, participation or dismantling activities during, before and after the convention. Exhibitors also assume all risks of loss, injury, theft or damage of any kind or nature whatsoever to any exhibit or component thereof, including, but not limited to, goods, merchandise, cash, records or any other property. Further, exhibitors are expressly bound, at their expense, to repair any damage which they cause to the bazaar fixtures, the surrounding areas, and the Living Arts Centre through unauthorized modifications or movement of their exhibit.

b. Exhibitors and their staff indemnify and hold the Living Arts Centre harmless and respective agents against any claim or expenses arising out of the use of the exhibition premises. The exhibitor understands that neither MuslimFest nor the Living Arts Centre maintain insurance covering the exhibitor's property and it is the sole responsibility of the exhibitor to obtain such insurance.

18. MuslimFest reserves the right to retract the confirmation letter and contract and therefore close any exhibit and eject any exhibitor or exhibitor's staff immediately from the Bazaar and conference who/which participate(s) in illegal or un-ethical activities, violate(s) any of the terms or conditions of this agreement and will immediately comply with instruction given by the MuslimFest Bazaar committee.
